

NEW Mobile Integrated Health program

Introducing a program to bring mental health and addiction services, supporting withdrawal management, directly to the City of Yorkton surrounding communities. This mobile service model, developed in consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority, will give individuals the care they need to overcome addictions and live healthy, safe lives in recovery.



PROGRAM MANAGER

Medavie Health Services (MHS) is a national leader in primary health care solutions and Canada's largest contracted provider of emergency medical services. MHS is part of Medavie, a national not-for-profit, health solutions partner, together with Medavie Blue Cross, an all-in-one private health insurer and public health program administrator. Services will be delivered by an operating subsidiary of MHS that focuses on MIH and other non-traditional healthcare services.

WITHDRAWAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES

The program will be integrated with the healthcare resources of each region to build addictions treatment capacity and help more individuals safely detox in their communities.

Services offered include:

- Clinical assessments and diagnostics
- Administration of IV fluids and medications
- Vital sign monitoring
- Wellness checks
- Phlebotomy
- Pain symptom management
- Clinical illness/disease surveillance
- Health system navigation
- Antibiotic administration

COLLABORATION FOR A HEALTHIER FUTURE

This is the third withdrawal-management focused program that MHS will manage in Saskatchewan. It is made possible by a partnership with the Saskatchewan Health Authority, in collaboration with community partners.

COMMITMENT TO TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION

The program responds to community requests for addictions support and the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action on Indigenous health care.
